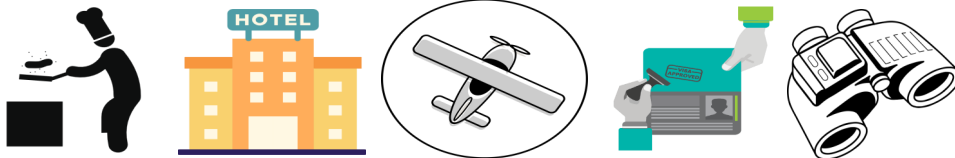

Day wise Itinerary

Day—1 Sao Paulo

Arrive in Sao Paulo - mainly known as the financial hub and the epicenter of Brazil's economy, but it's also a real melting pot of cultures.

Day —2 Sao Paulo — Manaus

Morning enjoy panoramic city tour of Sao Paulo which includes visit to traditional Vila Madalena neighborhood, where we'll stop at Beco do Batman to see its murals decorated with street art. This alley is full of colorful graffiti that bring the neighborhood to life and have made it one of the most visited corners of Sao Paulo. Later visit Nossa Senhora do Brasil. Walk along Avenida Paulista – The city's most important financial centre. Make a brief stop at the Casa das Rosas (House of Roses), the oldest house on this street. We will continue to Ibirapuera Park, where we will see the Bandeiras monument and learn about the history of the bandeirantes. The tour will continue with a panoramic visit to the Liberdade neighborhood, which is home to several Buddhist temples and Japanese gardens. See Se Cathedral and Pateo do Colegio. Flight to Manaus. Arrive in Manaus - located in the center of the world's largest rainforest, the city where you get an opportunity to be in the jungles of Amazon.

Day—3 Manaus

Board the Amazon River Cruise to see the stunning meeting of the waters where river Negro meets the Soli Moi. You might be lucky to get glimpse of Grey and Pink river dolphins and local fishermen. Extra Topping: Tea / Coffee during Amazon River Cruise.

Day—4 Manaus — Rio de Janeiro

Flight to Rio de Janeiro. Arrive in Rio de Janeiro, one of the most exciting city of Brazil .

Day—5 Rio de Janeiro

City tour includes visit to Pepino Beach, Ipanema Beach and Copacabana Beach, Downtown Rio, Metropolitan Cathedral and the Sambadrome. Visit Maracana Stadium from Inside (Subject to Operation). Evening free time for Leisure.

Day—6 Rio de Janeiro— Iguazu Falls

Start the day with cable car ride to the Sugar Loaf Mountain. Visit to the Corcovado - upon which stands the famous 'Christ the Redeemer' statue. We take a cogwheel train to this famous statue. Enjoy the stunning panorama from the top. Flight to Iguazu Falls.

Day—7 Iguazu Falls

Visit to Iguazu Falls. Enjoy Boat ride in Iguazu Fall - The Iguazu (also called Iguassu) Falls are composed of 275 separate cascades, which make it the largest broken waterfall in the world.

Day—8 Iguazu Falls —Lima

Flight to Lima – The capital city of Peru. Arrive in Lima.

Day—9 Lima

Morning city tour includes old and new Lima, the Plaza de Armas, the Town Hall, the Palace of the Arch bishop, the Cathedral and the Plaza San Martin. Visit St. Francis Church and View Catacombs from inside.

Day—10 Lima — Cuzco

Flight to Cuzco. Arrive in Cuzco - One of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the Western Hemisphere. The city stands high in the Andes at an average elevation of 11,150 feet at the west end of the Huatanay valley, a basin extending 20 miles east to Huambutio.

Day—11 Cuzco — Machu Picchu — Cuzco

Full day excursion to the new wonder of the world – Machu Ruins by train followed by Inca city in the foggy mountain jungle. Machu Picchu is a mystical place, A monument to divinity, where people feel that they are a creation of God. It is one of the most popular archaeological sites in the world. The Citadel of Machu Picchu in Quechua language 'Old Mountain' is known throughout the World for its amazing ruins. See the mighty currents of the Urubamba River and the huge blocks of limestone required for the construction of the city to the top of the Andes Mountains. Return by train to Cuzco.

Day—12 Cuzco

City tour includes the Inca empire, the Plaza de Armas, the ruins of the Inca Palace and the Old Town with its restored colonial buildings.



Day—13 Cuzco — Buenos Aires

Take a flight to Buenos Aires. Arrive in Buenos Aires. On arrival enjoy city tour includes Plaza de Mayo, Casa Rosada, Cabildo - town hall, Metropolitan Cathedral, districts of San Telmo and La Bocca, cemetery of Recoleta, Avenida 9 de Julio - the widest avenue in the world and the Palermo.

Day—14 Buenos Aires —El Calafate

Take a Flight to El Calafate. Arrive in El Calafate.

Day—15 El Calafate — Perito Moreno Glacier Buenos Aires

Proceed to Perito Moreno Glacier one of the world's largest active continental glaciers UNESCO has declared it Universal Mankind's Heritage. It is world famous for its loud loosening of huge icebergs. Enjoy Boat Ride at Perito Moreno Glacier. Take a flight to Buenos Aires. Arrive in Buenos Aires.

Day—16 Departure from Buenos Aires

Proceed to Airport. Board the flight to your Home Town. Tour Concludes
